It is hereby notified that the following are the resolutions of the emergency online Teachers' Council meeting held on 17.06.2023 to discuss urgent matters related to the modalities of admission for academic session 2023-2024 under Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP) as per NEP, 2020:

1. The choice of allied minors for Semester 1, 2 & 5 students with major in various subjects offered by the college for the Three and Four-Year B.A. and B. Sc. Undergraduate Programme are as follows:

2. The following subject-wise intake capacity for the Four-Year B.A. and B. Sc. Undergraduate Programme (with Honours), strictly following the reservation policy, was approved by the Teachers' Council:

3. The subject-wise intake capacity (total 72 seats) for the Three-Year B.A. Undergraduate Programme was revised and approved in the Teachers' Council meeting, strictly following the reservation policy, in the following manner:

- 4. Previously no seat was allotted for the B.Sc. General Programme. In view of the intimation from the University of Burdwan regarding allotment of 49 seats for the Three-Year B.Sc. Degree Programme under the CCFUP as per NEP 2020, the matter was placed in the Teachers' Council meeting held on 17.06.2023. Departments of Botany and Chemistry expressed willingness to introduce the Three-Year B.Sc. Degree Programme with Botany and Chemistry as major disciplines. Department of Zoology cited infrastructural issues such as paucity of classrooms, laboratory and laboratory attendant as matters of careful consideration before the introduction of the Three-Year B.Sc. Degree Programme. It was unanimously resolved, after prolonged discussion, that the Three-Year B.Sc. Degree Programme will be introduced in due course, subject to approval of the Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal. Stakeholders requested the Officer-In-Charge to communicate with the higher authorities in this regard and facilitate the introduction of the Three-Year B.Sc. Degree Programme with the intake capacity approved by the University of Burdwan, provided infrastructural preconditions are available.
- 5. Revision of the fee structure for new admission under the CCFUP as per NEP 2020 was proposed by the Officer-In-Charge, considering the introduction of the Four-Year Degree Programme with Honours. The Teachers' Council unanimously approved the proposal. Revised fee structure will be published in the admission brochure for academic session 2023-2024 and the college website in due course, after careful consideration of the financial aspects of the extension of the UG Programme by one year as per provisions of NEP, 2020.
