The Save Bird Campaign held in Padimpur Free Primary School on 23.03.2022, engaged young children and the school community to gain knowledge on certain main issues like: 1. variety of birds 2. identification of birds observed by local people everyday 3. knowing what kind of difficulties birds face during extreme hot temperature 4. protecting birds and help them to survive.

f) Brief Summary of the Programme: On 23/03/2022, the NSS Unit-1 volunteers of Government General Degree College Mangalkote conducted the save birds campaign programme actively in the Padimpur Free Primary School. The main objective of the campaign was to provide general awareness about how to save birds in our natural environment. The volunteers handed-over pamphlets with different pictures of birds with names in the school, so that young students can



learn and identify the birds easily. Then knowledge about the importance of maintaining our natural habitat by helping birds to survive was imparted to all, as many species of birds are dying and getting extinct due to change in weather conditions as trees are being cut down, increasing pollution and global warming in the environment. The volunteers motivated and encouraged everyone that it is the duty and responsibility of the members of the society to get involved and contribute in their own way to save nature through protecting greenery and being conscious about the well-being of birds and animals by building shelters, providing food and water. The campaign ended by making the students hang water bowls in the windows and nearby places as an initial measure to provide relief to the birds in extreme summer weather.

3. **Participants:** Enthusiastic NSS volunteers of the college participated in the save birds campaign under the leadership of the NSS Programme Officer, Mr. Aritra Rudra, Assistant Professor of History, Mr. Hirak Kumar Sinha Mahapatra, Assistant Professor of History, and Mr. Molla Hafizur Rahaman, Assistant Professor in English among other teachers of the college. Young students of the Padimpur Free Primary School, school authorities, teachers and the inhabitants of the local village also participated actively in the save bird campaign programme.
4. **Result of the Programme:** Students, teachers and local stakeholders participated actively in the programme and promised to help in their own way to save birds throughout the year in the village and elsewhere to ensure the well-being of the natural environment and the bird community at large.
