#### **DETAILED REPORT:**

- 1. Aims and Objectives of the Programme: Tobacco addiction causes many health hazards and diseases like Cancer, Coronary Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), heart ailments and strokes, Asthma and many other health issues which reduce the lifespan of people. Spreading awareness on the adverse effects of smoking cigarettes as well as intake of other tobacco related products is essential to reduce or completely stop the usage of it as passive smokers, second-hand smokers, and surrounding people all get affected equally. It creates a harmful influence on children and the youth making them addicted to tobacco from a very young age. Governments all around the world, including India, have passed laws prohibiting smoking in public places. Schools, Colleges and other institutions that have enacted laws banning the use of tobacco products at all indoor and outdoor campus sites are considered to have tobacco-free campuses, benefitting all. Therefore, NSS Unit of GGDC Mangalkote has arranged an outreach programme on "Anti-Tobacco Campaign" by visiting Mangalkote Block Development Office on 26stAugust, 2022. The main objectives of this programme are:
- Demonstrate how the authorities and staffs of Mangalkote BDO can contribute to making a sustainable, tobacco-free world, either by committing to never taking up tobacco products, or by quitting the habit.
- Spreading Awareness on the adverse effects of both active and passive smoking.

f) Brief Summary of the Programme: On 26th August 2022, the NSS unit of GGDC Mangalkote, along with other students of the college, conducted an Anti-Tobacco Campaign in Mangalkote BDO, around 12:00 P.M. Students carried Anti-Tobacco placards and participated in the campaigning programme, educating nearby villages along with all the BDO staffs about the detrimental effects of tobacco consumption including cancer, respiratory issues (COPD), diabetes, asthma, and heart disease. They also emphasized the hazards of both active and passive smoking on human health. Local people were urged to consider quitting smoking for their overall well-being by the NSS members. The campaign concluded at 2:00 pm after which the students returned to their college.

- **4. Result of the Programme:** The NSS unit convinced the nearby localities and community people to quit tobacco-consumption due to its harmful impact. The interactive approach fostered open communication, allowing villagers to ask questions and share their perspectives on tobacco use. The campaign was well appreciated by the authorities of the Mangalkote BDO as well as all the local people who willingly interacted with the NSS Unit.
