school campus. The activity started by explaining the students about the harmful

the need for clean campus. The volunteers enthusiastically placed bins throughout





the campus and encouraged young children in the class to use the bins to dispose any kind of dry and/or wet garbage so that the school environment remains clean and green. The volunteers with the participation of students used brooms to accumulate the waste materials at one place and then disposed them to the suitable bins.
