2. Responsibilities of the Institutions

The two institutions identify that the execution of any agreed upon activity will depend uson the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and the availability of financial resources, space and other resources. Accordingly, the functioning of any exchangesor collaborative programs based on this MoU shall be conferred anddetermined between the two institutions. It is further expected that both the institutions will be compliant with allapplicable legislations of Government of India and State and University policies.

Duration and Option to Amend, Extend or Terminate

This Moll will become effective when signed by authorities of both institutions. The

may be renewed or amended by mutual agreement of theinstitutions. The institutions should agree to periodically review the activities undertaken and the progress made and toconsult concerning amendments, renewal or termination of this MoU. Either authority may terminate this MoU at anytime by providing written notice prior to three months before such termination to the other authority.

4. General Terms

This MoU is not intended to, and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable by law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents. Nothing in this MoU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other esources in support of projects or activities between the two parties. Neither party will use the name of the other, either expressly or by implication, in any publicity, solicitation or advertisement without the express written approval of the other party to this MoU.


