roots of environmentalism can be traced back to political thinkers like Rousseau, Henry

David Thoreau and Mahatma Gandhi. Thus green-politics will enable students to

understand the core issues of social justice, democracy, decentralization, respect for

diversity, non-violence, global responsibility and their interrelationship with

environmental conservation and sustainable development.

nature like sustainable policy developer, green analyst, special advisor to the

CORRELATION TO SITUATEDNESS OF THE INSTITUTION
