OBJECTIVE OF THE SEMINAR:

The objective of the seminar was to enhance the soft skills of the students in terms of decisionmaking keeping in mind the vulnerabilities and indecisiveness of students belonging to the agegroup of college-goers.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE SEMINAR:

The speaker began her deliberation by describing how Decision-making is an integral part of our everyday life, whether as part of an organization or in our personal space. She further referred to it as a process of making choices based not only on scientific technics and human logic but also our values, beliefs, level of cognition, empathy, habits, experiences and so on and so forth. She also pointed out that It varies from person to person; what is logical action for one can be illogical for another. So, there is no one correct way of deciding one's course of action. She described the concept of decision-making as the making of rational, efficient, selfinterested and purposeful choices that should maximize profit and minimize stress and loss. As such, decisions should be goal oriented; analytical; have alternatives; dynamic; continuous; committed to time, effort and money; and humane. She went on to describe the steps to logical decision-making which include identifying the decision to be made, gathering relevant information, identifying alternative solutions, calculating the evidence, reviewing the decision and taking action. She then referred to the various skills that go into making a good decision emotional intelligence, creativity, critical thinking, problem solving skills, leadership qualities, time-management skill, collaborative or team work, etc. Finally, she concluded her talk by describing how to practice those skills and implement them in daily life.


