#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME**

Tobacco use is the leading global contributor to preventable disease and premature mortality, killing half of its users before they reach reproductive maturity. Use of tobacco increases the chance of developing diseases such as cancer, cardiovascular disease (CVD), diabetes, chronic pulmonary disease, stroke, infertility, blindness, TB, oral cavities, etc. According to the Global Youth Cigarettes Survey (GYTS), 2009, 14.6% of Indian youths between the ages of 13 and 15 use tobacco. Many health issues, such as more frequent and severe asthma episodes, respiratory infections, ear infections, sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS), coronary heart disease, stroke, lung cancer, etc., are brought on by passive smoking or second-hand smoke exposure in newborns, youths, and adults. Governments all around the world, including India, have passed laws prohibiting smoking on school grounds. Colleges and institutions that have enacted laws banning the use of tobacco products at all indoor and outdoor campus sites are considered to have tobacco-free campuses. Therefore, NSS Unit of GGDC Mangalkote has arranged an outreach programme on "Anti-Tobacco Campaign" by visiting Mathrun High School on 21st July, 2022. The main objectives of this programme are:

- Highlight the links between the use of tobacco products, tobacco control and sustainable development.
- Demonstrate how individuals can contribute to making a sustainable, tobacco-free world, either by committing to never taking up tobacco products, or by quitting the habit.
- Spread Awareness on the adverse effects of both direct and passive Smoking.

## PROCEEDINGS OF THE PROGRAMME

On 21st July, 2022 NSS unit of our college visited Mathrun High school which is located at a distance around 5 km from the College campus. NSS coordinator Mr. Aritra Rudra has already informed of the Head-Teacher of the School about the "Anti-Tobacco Campaign" and thus with together their joint initiative the programme has begun on 11 am. The head teacher has gathered students of class IX, X, XI and XIII in a large class room and then he introduced the faculty members from GGDC Mangalkote in front of students. NSS coordinator has given a brief overview of the programme and then requested Dr. Debasish Kundu, Assistant Professor in Chemistry, GGDC Mangalkote, to deliver the lecture.

Dr. Debasish Kundu has discussed all the critical effects of consuming tobacco on health. He also discussed how active and passive smoking are harming mankind day by day. The relation of tobacco consumption with different diseases such as cancer, respiratory problems (COPD), diabetics, Asthma, heart disease was explained by him. At the end of the lecture, the students interacted with several quarries related to tobacco consumption and the programme was ended by a short speech of Head -Teacher of the School.

MATHRUN NABIN CHANDRA INSTITUTION, The Second party and represented herein by the Head Master as Representative and Competent Authority (Hereinafter represented as "Second Party", the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in office, administrators and assigns)

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

#### WHEREAS

- A) FIRST PARTY is a Government College named:

### Clause-I CO-OPERATION

- Faculty and student exchanges based on reciprocity;
- Exposure of school students to state of the art laboratories and academic ambience of HEI;
- Team taught courses, including online courses for vocational opportunities;
- Visits by faculty, professional staff and students;
- Exchange of information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational programmes;
- Joint organization of workshops and educational fair, and short-term continuing-education programmes on topics of mutual interest, inviting each other's faculty and students to participate therein;
- Joint organization of cultural programme, sports and other creative events to hunt talents and
- Any other joint venture for co-curricular and extra-curricular enrichment of both the Institution on prior agreement of the Head of the Institution of both the Institution; within the Institution and its related wings.
- 1.2 Both the Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.3 First Party and Second Party must respect each other's to intellectual property and the disputes if any, relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, HOI of both the Institution will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.
- 1.4 Both the Parties mutually agreed not to include any financial transaction during the execution of this MOU.
- 1.5 Neither Party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligation under this MOU due to circumstances beyond their control but not limited to pandemic, war, flood etc. If such condition continues beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.
- 1.6 Nothing in this MOU shall be constructed to make party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose. Now onwards both the party may mention the name and LOGO of the other in their documents as "COLLABORATOR" for purpose as may be required subject to communication by the user to the other party in writing beforehand.

1.7 This MOU unless terminated by mutual written agreement will continue for 5 years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph and can be renewed through mutual interest. Either Party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this adultive of 90 days prior written notice to the other party.
