PROCEEDINGS OF THE PROGRAM

Mr. Keshab Chandra Saha's lecture highlighted Satyajit Ray's significant contribution to documentary film making, show casing his lesser known yet impactful works in the genre. Mr. Saha explored Ray's early experiments with documentary films, such as Rabindranath Tagore (1961), Sikkim (1971), The Inner Eye (1974), Bala (1976), Sukumar Ray (1987), demonstrating his innovative story telling approach. He analysed Ray's use of visual metaphors and poetic narration, which added depth and complexity to his documentaries Saha also discussed Ray's collaboration with noble writers and intellectuals, like Ray's work with Ritwik Ghatak on 'Jukti Takko Aar Gappo' (1974). The lecture revealed how documentary films not only reflected his artistic vision but also served as a platform for social commentary and critique. Mr. Saha's insightful analysis demonstrated Ray's pioneering role in shaping India's documentary film making inspiring students to explore this aspect of Ray's oeuvre.

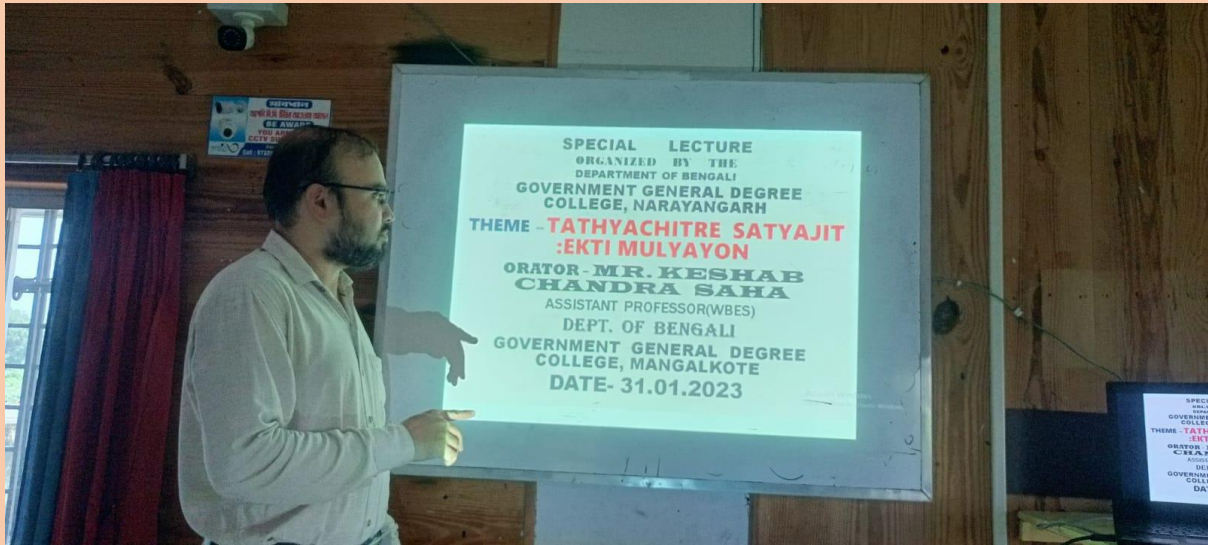

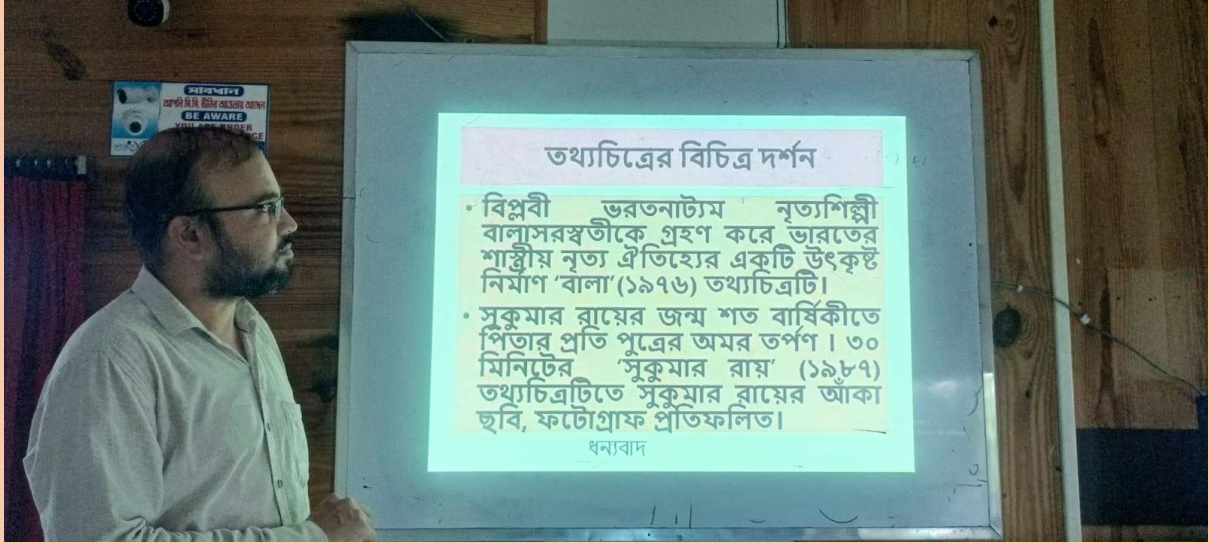

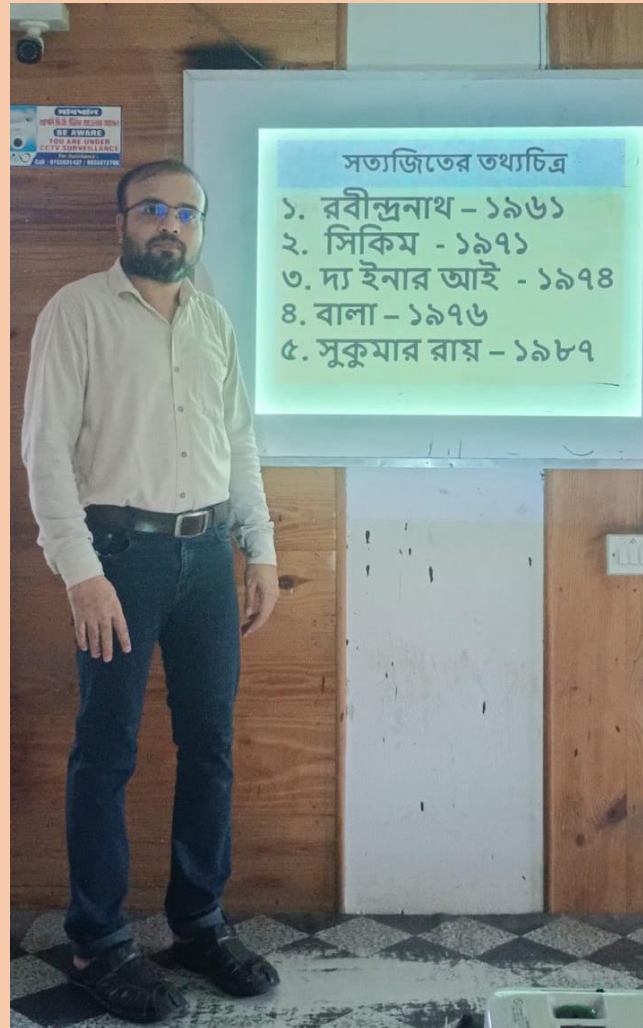

GOVERNMENT GENERAL DEGREE COLLEGE, NARAYANGARH a reputed higher education institution, located at P.O: Rathipur, Dist: Pachim Medinipur (W.B.) INDIA, PIN-721437 as the **SECOND PARTY**.

Both the parties herein have noted the importance of the value of cooperation and have agreed to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) regarding academic collaboration. The purpose of this non-binding MoU is to make possible academic and cultural exchange between both the parties based on the principles of mutual equality and the reciprocity of benefits. NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is agreed by and between both the colleges hereto as follows:

1. Objectives, Scope and Major Activities:

Both institutions agree to encourage the development of the following types of activities:


- Formal exchange of faculty members in specific mutually agreed upon areas of education, research and outreach.
- Cooperate in under-graduate education and training through library as well as laboratory resources, and also share access to E-Resources (such as N-List, INFLIBNET).
- Organize joint conferences, seminar, webinar, symposia, or other meetings on subjects of mutual interest.
- Exchange of academic information and materials.
- Pursue avenues for student exchange during the academic year.
- Explore the possibilities for developing joint research programs and collaborations.

2. Responsibilities of the Institutions

The two institutions identify that the execution of any agreed upon activity will depend upon the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and the availability of financial resources, space and other resources. Accordingly, the functioning of any exchanges or collaborative programs based on this MoU shall be conferred and determined between the two institutions. It is further expected that both the institutions will be compliant with all applicable legislations of Government of India and State and University policies.

Nothing in this MoU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support of projects or activities between the two parties. Neither party will use the name of the other, either expressly or by implication, in any publicity, solicitation or advertisement without the express written approval of the other party to this MoU.

5. Signatures

This MoU is valid for 5 years and shall enter into force on the date of the signing by qualified representatives of both institutions.


