f. Purpose or Objective of the Program: To create awareness and a sense of understanding among students of our college regarding the harmfulness and the necessity to abolish child marriage in our society in the form of informative and interactive power-point presentation.

g. Name and Designation of the First Speaker: Ms. Sanchari De, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology, Government General Degree College Mangalkote, Burdwan, West Bengal, India.

h. Topic of Deliberation: Child Marriage: A Social Peril.

i. Summary of the Deliberation of the First Speaker:

The speaker highlighted the significance of such awareness programme by depicting a statistical report by UNICEF portraying the grave situation of recorded child marriage cases all over India and in which States it occurred more. She further conveyed that why it is a crime and peril for the girl-child as well as for the society by explaining the violation of child rights, basic school education rights and psychological, emotional and physical health hazards attached with it. The speaker then discussed the various reasons like poverty, patriarchal mind-set and values and the ritual of bride-price and dowry system prevalent in the society, behind the high cases of child marriage in India. She then further spoke about The Prohibition of Child Marriage Act 2006, revealing the legal marriageable age for boys and girls and that marriage below the age of 18 is considered a crime and is a punishable act for an adult male or parents of the victim or the person involved with such act for two years of imprisonment and/or a fine up-to Rs.1 lakh. The speaker also focused on some child rights policies 'child-line 1098', 'Kanyashree Prakalpa' initiated and implemented by the government as well as by voluntary organizations like 'CRY', 'UNICEF', 'CINI' and others who all are trying to take a step further to stop child marriage cases in society for the betterment of it. Finally, she ended her lecture by motivating and encouraging the students to take initiative by



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calling help-line numbers and complaining to near-by police stations whenever they come across child-marriage act taking place in their neighbourhood or village as this one step will save and protect the life of a girl-child.

B. GENERAL INFORMATION RELATING TO PARTICIPATION AND FEEDBACK:

Students and faculty members from all the departments of the college participated in the awareness programme held on 10th March 2023. After each lecture delivered by the speakers, some students shared their own life-experiences and views on the topic discussed. The officer-in charge, IQAC Coordinator and other faculty members of the college also provided their valuable insights on the topic of child marriage to enlighten the audience.

It has been a learning experience for the organizing committee to organize this Kanyashree Awareness Programme in accordance with the notice published by the “Office of the District Magistrate and Collector, Purba Bardhaman, District Project Management Unit, Kanyashree Prakalpa, New Administrative Building, 3rd Floor, Purba Bardhaman-713101, Govt of West Bengal” (Memo No: 91/DPMU/KP/PBDN/XII/57 dated 28.02.2023) on “Child Marriage Prevention”. 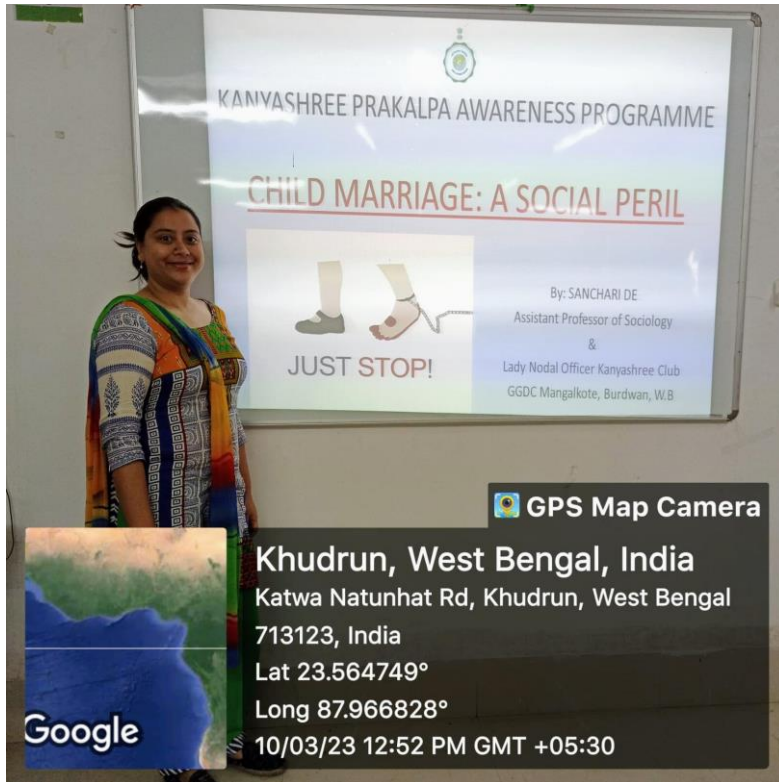

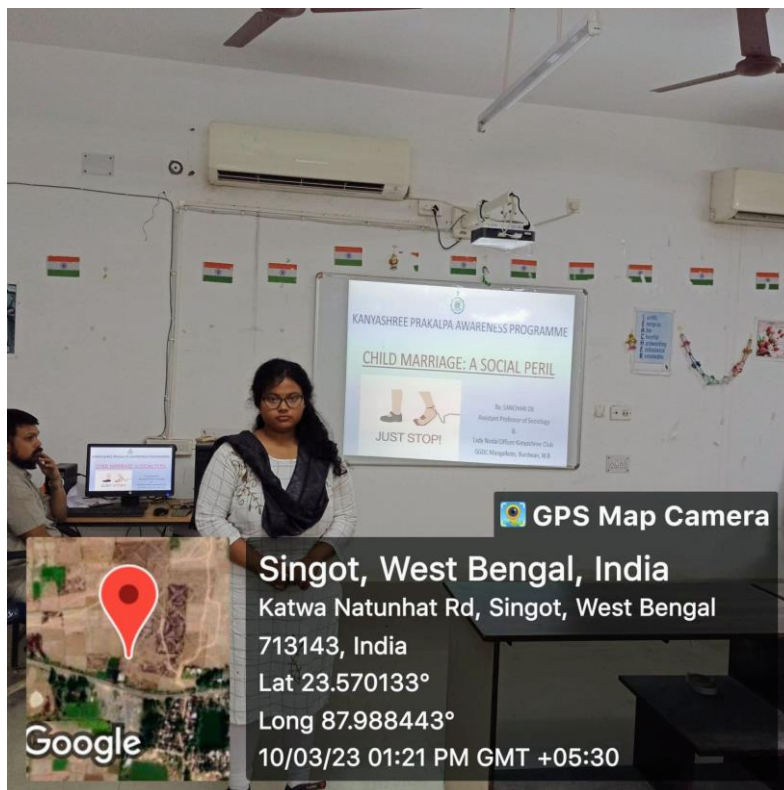
