OBJECTIVE OF THE SEMINAR:

The seminar was organised to make the students aware of the much-hyped technological development that has been taking the IT industry by storm. 'Artificial Intelligence' or 'AI' has become a topic of discussion in almost all international platforms and like any other scientific technology it has its own advantages and drawbacks. All these details were intended to be discussed in the seminar.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE SEMINAR:

The speaker began his deliberation by describing how Artificial Intelligence (AI) is rapidly evolving and revolutionizing the way we live and work. He gave examples of voice assistants like Siri and Alexa and went on to self-driving cars and chatbots, to stress on the fact that AI is increasingly becoming a part of our daily lives. Nevertheless, no matter how promising they seem to be they have their own pitfalls, many of which goes against the human race, that have emerged as a matter of concern worldwide. These drawbacks have prevented their unanimous acceptance from every corner. These were described by the speaker while introducing the topic. He then went on to describe the benefits of AI which includes automation of tasks which would otherwise be time-consuming and labour-intensive. To substantiate this, he gave examples of AI-powered robots which can perform complex surgeries with greater precision than human surgeons reducing human errors and allowing the doctors to focus more on critical aspects of patient care. He further described the applications of AI in the industrial sector where it can be used to analyse data related to seasonal fluctuations in businesses and customer-behaviour which can be largely used to revamp business strategies. In the next part of his lecture, the speaker described the pitfalls of too much dependence on AI that has been stirring the human society. The most discussed of all topics is the joblessness it can lead to due to automation. Then there have been reports of biases and skewed decisions with AI because of its prior-programming which can interfere with the actual research outcomes in businesses and social sciences-oriented research. The speaker highlighted these arts. Then, there are issues of leakage of sensitive information, be it private or concerning national security due to technical glitches or purposely that may have serious future implications as elaborated by the speaker. Eventually,

the speaker concluded the lecture by highlighting the ethical issues associated with the use of AI that has led to the global controversy.
