OBJECTIVE OF THE SEMINAR:

The programme aims to analyse the works of a coveted poet, novelist, storyteller and a critic in Bengali Language, the very learned Sunil Gangopadhyay. It will try to help students appreciate the rich Indian literature.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE SEMINAR:

The speaker began his lecture by describing the life of the famous writer Sunil Gangopadhyay since his birth in 1934 at Faridpur, currently located in Bangladesh. He described how the writer specialized in literature for children while maintaining his contributions in prose, poetry, short stories, plays and novels in Bengali language. The role of Sunil Gangopadhyay as a critic was also emphasized. Then, the speaker moved on to describe how the socio-political conditions of India had profound effects on his literary works and how he used his art as a medium to protest against the social evils. It was his magnum opus, *Sei Samaya*, which helped him win the prestigious ‘Sahitya Akademi Award’ in 1985. The speaker elaborated the content of his book which sprang from the 19th century Bengal renaissance. His literary contributions helped him win several accolades but the closest works to his heart were his poetries as described by the speaker. Eventually, in his concluding remark, the speaker described how art and literature can be a medium for social reforms as was exemplified by Sunil Gangopadhyay.
