Aims and objectives of the program

On 02.01.2022, GGDC, Mangalkote, organized an online interactive session as part of the Observation of Students' Week, 2022 – an initiative of the Government of West Bengal. Two online lectures were delivered by invited resource persons who deliberated on extremely pertinent issues such as blended mode of education and mental crises of the youth in contemporary times. Considering the troubled times that human society is going through, in the wake of the Covid 19 pandemic, the prolonged lockdown, the shift to online mode of education, the loss of life and uncertainty about future.

The objective of the online interactive session, with two lectures – one dealing with the significance of blending online and offline education in response to a rapidly changing education system and the other dealing with immense psychological stress students were faced with as a result of shift to online education, especially in a society like India with huge digital divide, was to acquaint the students with the productive role of online education and the ways of dealing with the mental stress characteristic of the youth and the troubled times they are in as a result of the uncertainty unleashed by the Covid 19 pandemic.

Proceedings of the program

The online interactive session began with a welcome speech by Ms. Tinat Rukhsana, Assistant Professor in Political Science, GGDC, Mangalkote. This was followed by the inaugural address by Dr. Saurabh Chakrabarti (WBSES), Principal, GGDC, Mangalkote and a special address by Dr. Pradipta Kumar Basu, Coordinator, IQAC, GGDC, Mangalkote.

The first lecture was delivered by Dr. Shantanu Chakrabarti (WBSES), Principal, GGDC, Singur. His talk was titled "Blending off and on campus: Scopes of New Normal Educational Delivery Systems" and dealt in detail with the possibilities and potentials of online education in a dynamic synergy with traditional face-to-face education system. The resource person urged both the students and the teachers to register for the wide variety of online courses offered by SWAYAM, NPTEL and the IITs.

The second lecture was delivered by Dr. Abanti Bhattacharyya, Assistant Professor in Psychology, GGDC, Singur. Her talk was titled Understanding Mental Health Problems amongst the Youth: Awareness and Prevention and acted as a psychological counseling session for the students trying to deal with mental crises in general and the unique psychological challenges thrown up by the pandemic.

Both the lectures where followed by interactive sessions where both students and teachers participated with great enthusiasm. The session ended with a formal vote of thanks by







Result of the program


