The objective of the seminar was to make the students aware about the importance of financial independence and how they can achieve them. It was also aimed to inform them about various alternative employment sources and supplementing their income to beat inflation.





PROCEEDINGS OF THE SEMINAR:

The speaker began her presentation by describing how unemployment has emerged as a huge problem in current times and the crisis in the job market. She then pointed out that entrepreneurship and start-ups can create greater employment opportunities for youth as evidenced by some budding entrepreneurs who have made their own way rather than engaging in nine to five jobs. She elaborated how the Indian start up ecosystem suffers from capital inadequacy in the seed and "Proof of Concept" development stage. She added that the capital required at this stage often presents a make-or-break situation for start-ups with good business ideas. Many innovative business ideas fall to take off due to the absence of this critical capital required at an early stage for proof of concept, prototype development, product trials, marketentry, and commercialization. Seed Fund offered to such promising cases can have a multiplier effect in the validation of business ideas of many start-ups, leading to employment generation. Having said that, she stressed on easy availability of capital is essential for entrepreneurs at the early stages of the growth of an enterprise. Funding from angel investors and venture capital firms becomes available to start-ups only after the proof of concept has been provided. Similarly, banks provide loans only to asset-backed applicants. It is essential to provide seed funding to start-ups with innovative ideas to conduct proof of concept trials. Eventually, she concluded her talk by giving examples of different funding opportunities provided by the Government of India and the Government of West Ben
