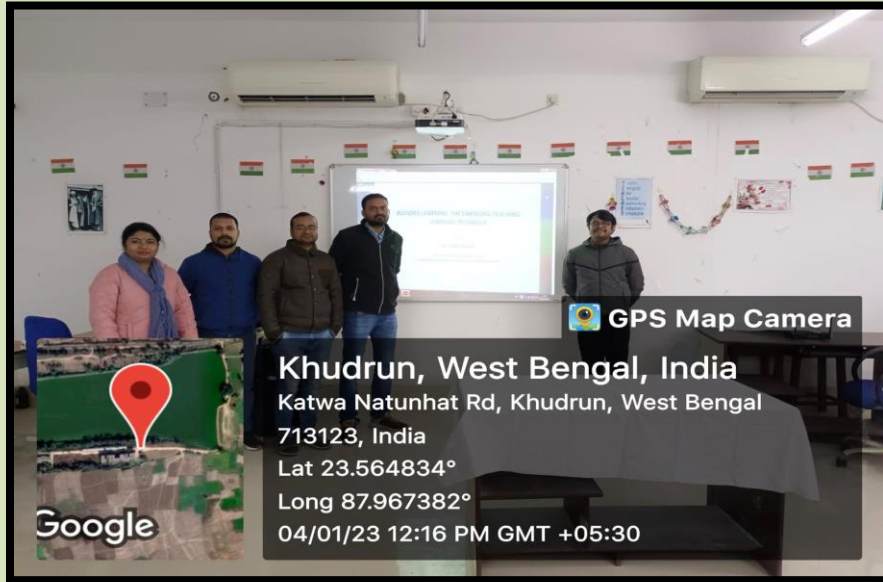

<b>Title of Presentation</b>	Blended Learning: The Emerging Teaching-Learning Technique
<b>Brief Summary of the Presentation</b>	<p><i>The resource person began by emphasizing on the dynamic nature of the educational system, which offers the scope for continuous experimentation with teaching and learning methods. He argued that with advancements in technology like the advent of internet and the use of mobile telephones, digital learning has gained great prominence in the contemporary times. Digital learning helps learners have control over the time, space, path and pace of teaching-learning or instruction, which the resource person argued, has concrete benefits over traditional system of academic learning. The point was however not to undermine or downplay the significance of the traditional system but to strike the right balance between the old and new – the emerging systems of virtual learning, resulting in a productive and interesting blended learning. Blended learning, according to the resource person, emphasizes on the synergy between instructor-led classroom-based or virtual learning and self-guided or self-assigned digital learning. The resource person demonstrated the possible ways of incorporating digital learning in the mainstream classroom-based training via pre and post-classroom virtual learning, and online assessments and follow-ups. Apart from the advantages of blended learning the resource person also focused on the challenges or barriers to such learning which includes linguistic barrier and conservative attitudes, availability of skills, resources and institutional support like free or subsidized and stable internet connectivity, which is a major concern in backward areas.</i></p>

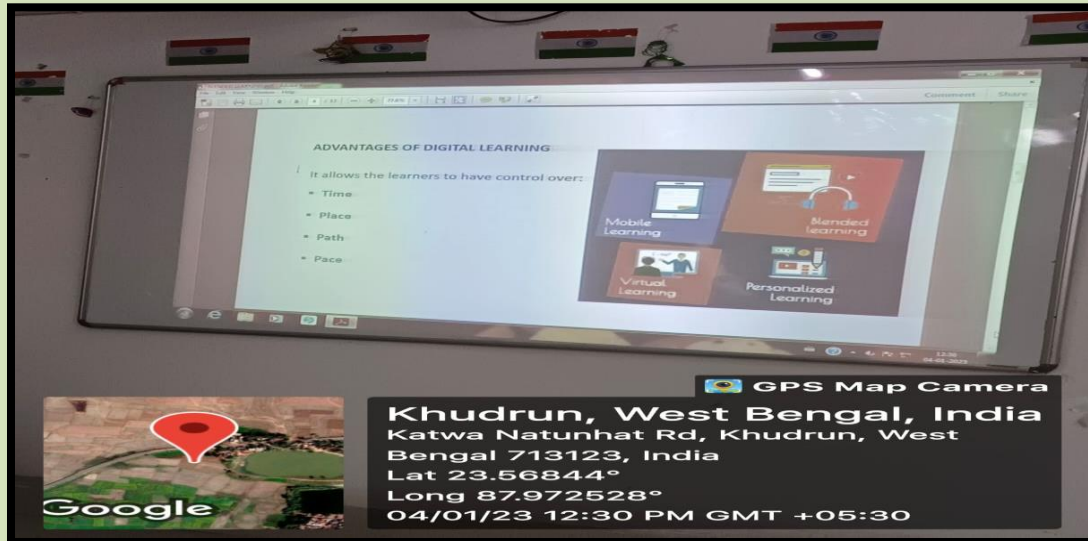
