The objective of the seminar was to enhance the entrepreneurial outlook in students and make them aware about the role of micro-finance in self-sustenance.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE SEMINAR:

The speaker began his presentation by describing the Self-Help Groups as the emerging tools of Microfinance System in India. He stressed that It is not only a mechanism of poverty alleviation but also a means of fostering more socially and economically desirable activities like income generation, environmental conservation, literacy, child and maternal care and nutrition. He went further to state that Self-Help Group system is designed to be an effective means of empowering rural women below the poverty line. Self help groups promote economic development and social security where micro-financing plays an important role. To promote this, several small finance banks have been developed to promote and strengthen this system. Delving into the details of the Self- Help Groups, he described them as a group of ten to twenty members who have a common perception of need and willingness to partake in collective action. Eventually, he concluded his speech by presenting the data of rising roles of microfinancing in promoting self-help groups and empowering the underprivileged sections of the society.
