

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2. TEACHERS USE STUDENT-CENTRIC METHOD:






Table 2: depicts that 95% of the participants agree that teacher use student-centric method to explain the curriculum while 5% of the respondents are undecided.




3. TEACHERS USE ICT-ENABLED TOOLS:


4. CURRCULUM ENRICHMENT THROUGH ADD-ON COURSES, SEMINARS, WORKSHOPS ETC.

Table 4: depicts that 95% of the participants are satisfied with the college enriching the curriculum through various add-on course, seminars and workshops, while 5% of them are undecided.




5. COLLEGE OFFICE IS ACCESSIBLE:

Inference: Through the analysis of Tables 1 to 7, a clear trajectory can be drawn where more than 95% of the alumni members are positively satisfied by the facilities and efforts of the college in raising the standard of education through a holistic development of the students. Though there are also some areas of improvements which were also pointed out by the alumni member. These are as follows:

25% of the respondents felt that the college library and the laboratories required upgradation. The next room for improvement was recorded in the development of IT infrastructure with 10% of the respondents. The last areas of improvements were recorded in the college infrastructure with 10%, overall cleanliness and toilets of the college with first two recording 10% and 20% respectively each of the responses.




Figure 8: Improvement Percentage
