ANNUAL REPORT 2018-2019

The Anti-Ragging Committee of Government General Degree College, Mangalkote has been established in conformity with the UGC norms and the National Anti-Ragging Policy Guidelines. Its members are committed to creating a ragging and harassment-free campus. To ensure that no sexual, physical or mental harassment take place within the campus, regular meetings are held by the Anti-Ragging Committee, wherein the members together with the HOI discuss various issues like vivid display of posters depicting the punishment for ragging and where and how help is available. Sensitization programmes and awareness camps are organized by the Committee, which not only include awareness talks by the faculty members but also interactive sessions with the students where they are encouraged to share their opinions and perspectives. In this session the following activities were undertaken by the Anti-Ragging Committee:

- Displaying of poster at the entrance of the College depicting ragging as a punishable offence and totally prohibited within the campus, the National Anti-Ragging Helpline number and email address, the numbers of the important functionaries of the Committee for help and whom to approach for redressal.
- An awareness camp for the newly admitted students, explaining to them what constitutes ragging and how and whom to approach for help.
- A sensitization programme for both the new and the senior students about the laws and guidelines of anti-ragging.
