ANNUAL REPORT 2019-2020

In this session one important function of the Anti-Ragging Committee was the drawing up of the Anti-Ragging Policy of the Institution in accordance with the National Anti-Ragging Guidelines (2009) i.e. "UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions." And it was decided by the HOI and the members of the Committee that once finalized the policy will come into immediate effect. It was decided that initially the redressal mechanism will be offline, that is through letters submitted directly to the HOI/Anti-Ragging Committee Convener/Visakha Cell Convener. Though complete anonymity will be maintained in all cases. Later on, a provision for online grievance redressal was also in the consideration of the Committee. Apart from this, in the session 2019-20, a sensitization programme was also organized by the Anti-Ragging Committee, especially for the newly admitted students of Semester I, where talks were delivered by Dr. Raj Kumar Singh, Officer-in-Charge, GGDCM, and Mr Hirak Kumar Sinha Mahapatra, Convener, Anti-Ragging Committee, regarding the meaning of ragging, its forms, its effect on the human mind and body, whom to report to in case of ragging, what are the punishments and how to report. It was an interactive session where the students were also asked to voice their opinions.
