ANNUAL REPORT 2023-2024

The Anti-Ragging Committee of Government General Degree College, Mangalkote was established in accordance with the UGC norms and the National Anti-ragging Policy guidelines, in 2022 via Notice No. 82/22 dated 26.09.2022. It is one of the key committees of the college, dedicated to securing the safety and security of the students. The Committee members along with the HOI regularly thrive to maintain a safe and healthy atmosphere in the college by taking the following steps:

- The Anti-Ragging Committee appears both in the college website and also the notice board.
- Holding of regular online and offline sensitization and awareness programmes especially before the start of a new session, attended by both the new and senior students.
- Displaying of posters with the Anti-Ragging Helpline Number both inside and outside the college building.
- The establishment of the Anti-Ragging Squad as an aide to the Anti-Ragging Committee, comprising of student representatives.
- Staff members take the initiative to guide newly admitted students to their respective classes at the start of each new session.
- The punishment prescribed for indulging in any kind of harassing activities are explained to the students by the HOI alongside awareness camps.

As a result, no complaints regarding ragging or any other kind of sexual harassment was not received by the Committee during this session. As this is a newly established college with about 300 students, it is possible for the staff members to keep a strict vigilance on the students. Moreover, it is more of a homely atmosphere of the college that maintains a cordial relation between the stakeholders.

The HOI and all the members of the Anti-Ragging Committee and the Anti-Ragging Squad have been instrumental in keeping a strict vigil over the students and spreading awareness about ragging and its pitfalls. As such no complaint of ragging has been received till now.
