# REPORT OF THE MENTOR-MENTEE PROGRAMME ACADEMIC SESSION: 2022-2023

## **OBJECTIVES**

Government General Degree College, Mangalkote, being a rural institution, faces unique challenges with its student population. Many students grapple with low self-confidence, stress, adapting to college-level education, and engaging comprehensively with the curriculum. Although committees are in place to assist with these issues, students often struggle to navigate the available resources effectively. The mentor-mentee programme was established to bridge this gap.

The primary aim of this programme is to identify these problems and work collaboratively towards sustainable solutions. By providing a structured support system, the programme helps students receive personalized guidance on various issues, from academic preparation to personal development. This fosters a supportive environment where students can build the necessary skills and confidence to succeed both academically and personally. The mentor-mentee programme is an integral component of the *Antarik* initiative of the college. The mentoring sessions also act as contexts for promoting student-centric and innovative teaching-learning methods.

### METHODOLOGY

Our college conducts the mentor-mentee programme biannually, following the internal exams each semester. This timing allows mentors to provide valuable feedback based on students' performance in both Continuous Internal Assessments (CIA) and centralized Internal Examination. The latter are crucial as their results are integrated into the university marks, making this feedback an important aspect of students' academic progression.

Mentor-mentee pairings are allocated centrally to ensure an organized approach. Mentors meet with their mentees to discuss individual performance and provide qualitative feedback. If specific issues are identified; these are addressed collectively in group sessions covering various topics such as:

- Overall performance or specific aspects of performance in CIA or centralized Internal Examination

- Preparation for or identification of problems leading to poor performance in University Examination

- Communication skills and nuances of self-expression

- Career guidance, employability enhancing skills and sensitization about emerging domains of work

- Gender, physical and mental health issues and so on.

These sessions aim to promote comprehensive development and equip students with essential life skills. The programme concludes with a feedback session where students share their experiences. This feedback is invaluable as it helps mentors and the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) refine the programme for future iterations.

During the present academic session, mentor-mentee sessions were held immediately after the completion of the Centralized Internal Examinations of Semester II, IV and VI. The following is the department-wise description of activities conducted during the mentor-mentee session across the three even semesters.

#### **BRIEF REPORTS OF DEPARTMENT-WISE MENTORING ACTIVITY DURING 2022-2023**

During the even semester (II, IV & VI) of academic session 2022-2023, the mentor-mentee programme commenced with the usual mentor-mentee pairing/allotment notification. Students of all semesters of each department were allotted mentors for addressing their concerns through collaborative engagements towards finding creative solutions.

Although the mentor-mentee sessions were held after the completion of the internal examinations, the mentees were informed about their mentors in advance and were asked to prepare a list of problems or challenges faced during the semester. Such problems or challenges were related generally to the curricular or teaching-learning aspects of the semester or individual needs or any extra-curricular concern of collective or group interest. The mentors took note of each of these concerns and during the mentor-mentee sessions, the mentors not only provided valuable feedback on the performance of the mentees in the CIAs and centralized internal assessments, they also conducted dedicated sessions on themes or issues raised by the mentees based on their common concerns or mutually agreed upon interests. These sessions were backed up with audio-visual aid in many cases, deploying student-centric approaches.

At the Department of Bengali, Mr. Keshab Chandra Saha dealt with time management in

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relation to comprehending and answering questions with the Semester II students. Dr. Koushik Kumar Dutta, along with his Semester IV mentees delved into the basics of pronunciation in poetry recitation. This session was backed up with ICT tools and student involvement, and was conducted in the form of a workshop. Mr. Debashis Biswas conducted a session on letter writing skills with his Semester VI mentee group.

At the Department of English, Ms. Tahira Tashneem, the mentor of all ongoing semesters conducted personalized sessions on issues as wide-ranging as organizing a student seminar collaboratively (semester II), discussion of specific problem areas such as partition literature and women's writings (semester IV) and comprehending and answering questions (semester VI).

At the Department of History, the mentors dealt mainly with the curricular concerns of the mentees. Mr. Hirak Kr. Sinha Mahapatra and Mr. Aritra Rudra conducted one-to-one remedial sessions with semester II and IV students on laws, diplomacy and espionage in relation to international politics and communalism, secularism and communitarianism respectively. Mr. Khokan Saikh conducted a remedial session with audio-visual aid on the topic 'from culture to civilization' with his semester VI mentee group.

At the Department of Political Science, Sk Sahafur Hoque conducted a session on improving Bengali vocabulary and disciplinary vocabulary of Political Science with semester II mentee group. Ms. Madhumita Chakraborty conducted a life-skill session on dealing with mental stress and a career guidance session on political science as career based on the demands of the semester IV and VI students.

At the Department of Sociology, Ms. Sanchari De conducted a session on English communication and Ms. Moumita Mazumder on effective communication with semester II and IV students respectively. Mr. Debaditya Dutta conducted one-to-one session with the semester VI students on gender.

The semester II students of the Department of Zoology had a doubt-clearing cum mentoring session with Dr. Animesh Mondal where the focus was on 'disorder in protein'. The session was aided with Power-Point Presentation to ensure effective learning. Dr. Dinesh Maity of Chemistry department discussed 'the role of metal ions in enzyme activity' with the semester IV students in his mentoring session with the help of Power-Point Presentation. Dr. Raj Kumar Singh of Botany department conducted a session on career prospects of Biological sciences today with semester VI students, the out-going batch of the Zoology department.

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#### OUTCOME

The mentor-mentee programme has yielded significant positive outcomes across various departments of the college. Each department tailors the programme to address specific needs, thereby enhancing students' skills in diverse areas. For instance, some departments focus on improving writing skills, while others emphasize ICT skills by teaching students how to create effective Power Point presentation.

Engagement and creativity are at the core of this programme, with departments organizing activities such as wall magazines, exhibitions, and other student-centric events. These activities not only enhance academic skills but also foster a sense of community and involvement among students. The programme also tackles broader issues like gender inequality and rural-urban disparities, ensuring students are equipped to handle such challenges.

The programme also addresses broader issues such as gender inequality, ensuring that students are aware of and can navigate such challenges effectively. By providing a holistic support system, the mentor-mentee programme at Government General Degree College, Mangalkote, helps students overcome academic and personal hurdles, thereby promoting their overall growth and success. Moreover, the programme has led to increased student engagement and motivation. Students report feeling more connected to their peers and mentors, which has enhanced their overall college experience. The personalized attention and tailored guidance provided by mentors have also resulted in improved academic performance and better stress management among students.

The introduction of creative problem-solving sessions has empowered students to approach challenges with a proactive mindset. Departments have also begun integrating practical workshops on topics such as career planning and digital literacy, further preparing students for future endeavours.

In conclusion, the mentor-mentee programme is a vital initiative supporting students in navigating their academic journey and personal development. Through individualized guidance and structured sessions, the programme helps students overcome challenges, develop essential skills, and achieve their full potential.
