## **PROCEEDINGS OF THE PROGRAMME:**

The webinar as a part of collaborative initiative , on the topic **Social Constraints and Women Emancipation in India**’, organized on the occasion of **International Women’s Day** featuring Mr. Abhisek Das, Assistant Professor of English, created a platform for gender sensitivity and inclusivity among students, faculty, and staff. The speaker explored strategies for women empowerment and emancipation, including education, economic independence, and legal rights.

Mr. Abhisek Das delivered an insightful lecture on Social Constraints and Women Emancipation in India, highlighting the intricate relationship between the two. He began by elucidating how deeply ingrained patriarchal norms and cultural conditioning perpetuate gender-based discrimination, limiting women's choices and opportunities. He encouraged the audience to question and challenge societal norms, promoting a culture of inclusivity and respect. Mr. Das concluded by celebrating women's resilience and achievements, urging the audience to recognize and support their contributions to society. The lecture sparked a thought-provoking discussion, inspiring the audience to reflect on their roles in shaping a more equitable society. Through his lecture, Das encouraged individuals to become agents of change, working collectively towards a future where women can thrive and reach their full potential.

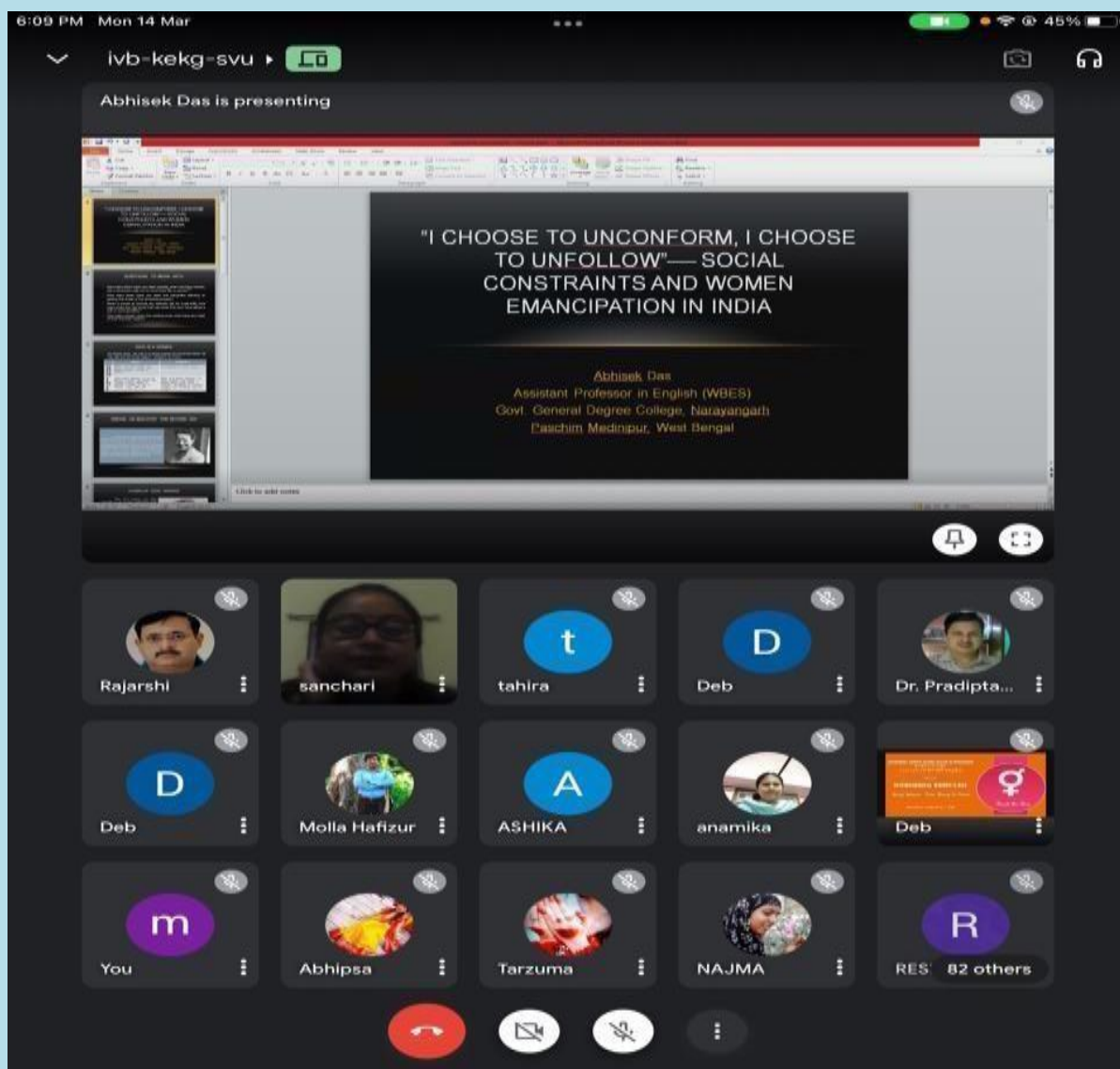
## **OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAMME:**

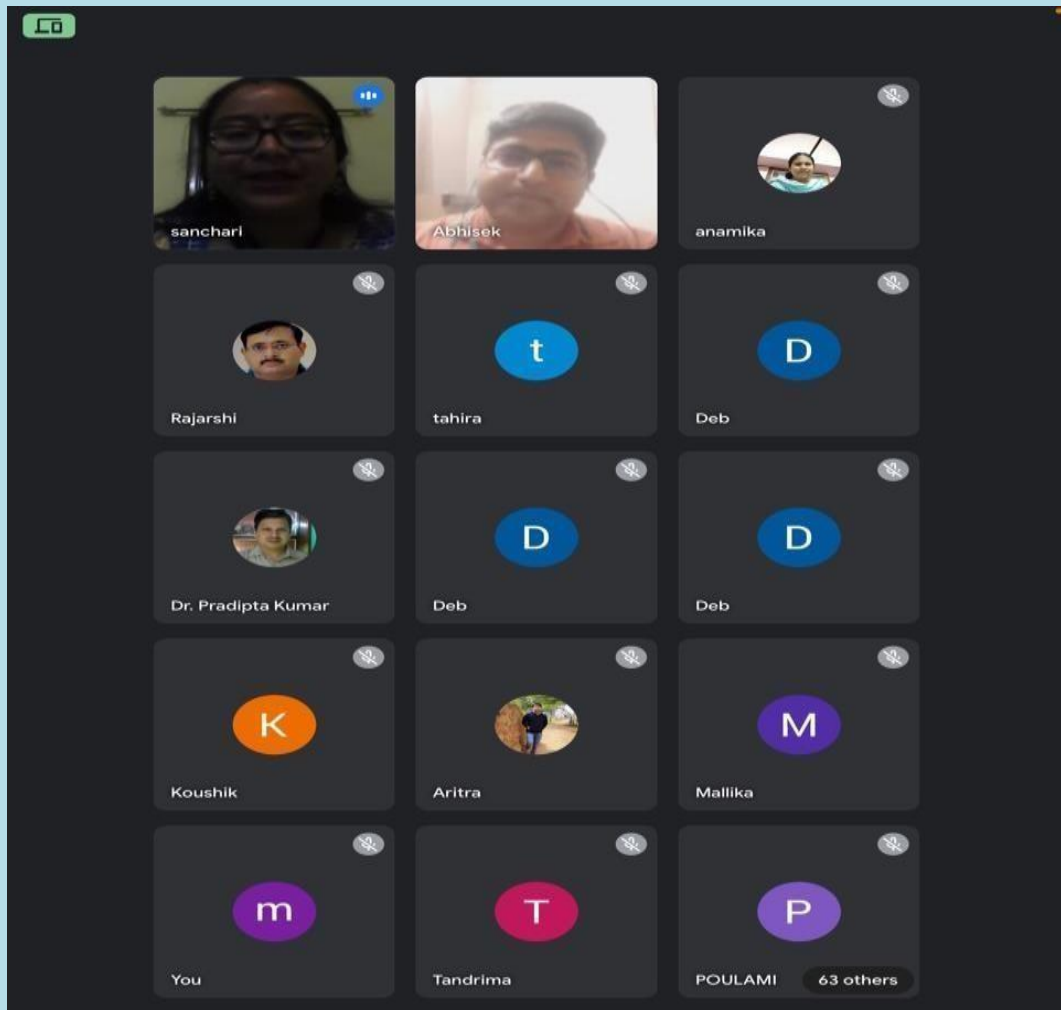

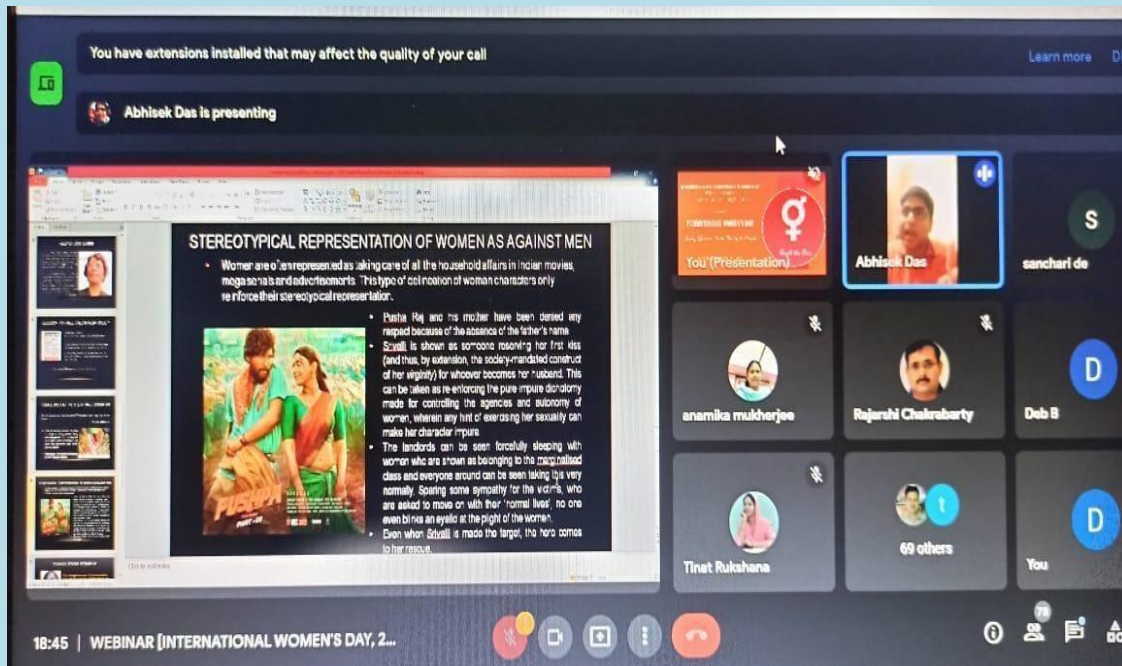


### 1. Objectives, Scope and Major Activities:

- Explore the possibilities for developing joint research programs and collaborations.


### 2. Responsibilities of the Institutions

Neither party will use the name of the other, either expressly or by implication, in any publicity, solicitation or advertisement without the express written approval of the other party to this MoU.

**5. Signatures**

This MoU is valid for 5 years and shall enter into force on the date of the signing by qualified representatives of both institutions.


