f. Purpose or Objective of the Program: To create awareness and a sense of understanding among students of our college regarding the abolition of gender discrimination in our society in the form of informative and interactive power-point presentation.

g. Name and Designation of the Second Speaker: Mr. Hirak Kumar Sinha Mahapatra, Assistant Professor, Department of History, Government General Degree College Mangalkote, Burdwan, West Bengal, India.

h. Topic of Deliberation: Gender and Gender Discrimination.

i. Summary of the Deliberation of the Second Speaker:

The speaker initiated the lecture by first explaining the concept of 'gender' and the fact that it is a social construct by providing relevant real-life examples so that students could connect and relate to it. He then elaborated how gender discrimination takes place in different spheres of our day to day life like in family through gendered socialization of a boy-child and a girl-child, in education system through schools, teachers, text-books, within religion through various ritual code-ofconduct showcasing hierarchical order between men and women, within workplace through gender wage-gap, glass-ceiling, gendered occupational segregation and sexual harassment, in politics where representation of males are more than females and how media plays a major role in creating gender discrimination through movies, advertisements, jingles, song lyrics and dance choreography. He further explained that due to patriarchal values, preference of boy-child is still more than girl-child and that the latter is still considered as 'weaker-sex', 'burden' and a 'liability' to family as well as society. He highlighted that gender-discrimination needs to be abolished as woman is no less than a man in-terms of cognitive abilities, skills and potential and so should not be targeted, humiliated, de-valued and disrespected by men and society at large. The speaker ended his speech by stating that, for a society to develop and progress economically, men and women



should be given equal value and opportunity to shine, then only it will be impactful and beneficial in the future.

B. GENERAL INFORMATION RELATING TO PARTICIPATION AND FEEDBACK:

Students and faculty members from all the departments of the college participated in the awareness programme held on 29th March 2023. After each lecture delivered by the speakers, some students shared their own life-experiences and views on the topic discussed. The officer-in charge and IQAC Coordinator of the college also provided their valuable insights on the topic of 'Gender Discrimination' to enlighten the audience.


