### 11. **Title of the Lecture/Deliberation:** *Development Sector as Career Option: Insights from Ground Reality*

#### 12. Summary of Lecture/Deliberation by the Invited Speaker/Resource Person:

This lecture helped to make students aware of the various career options that they can pursue after graduation, particularly in the development sector or in NGOs. This lecture began with an interactive discussion on the concept of development and what the terms 'development' or 'NGO' mean to most people. This helped students analyze their assumptions and notions regarding these terms and the sectors they represent. These terms and sectors are generally associated with charity, community support, and a certain image of a social worker. The lecture went on to discuss how one should streamline career options for deciding what profession to pursue after college. It then went on to elaborate on the ideas of charity, part time engagement, and full time engagement in development work. Charity was described as the act of giving resources, assistance, or support to those in need or to organizations working for the betterment of society. It involves voluntary contribution of people's time, money, goods, or services to help those facing challenges like poverty, illness, education, gaps, or social inequality. However, charity is usually done once or occasionally, it cannot be done every day or regularly enough to make a daily difference in someone's life. Part time work in the development sector refers to employment where individuals work fewer hours than the standard full time working week. In the development sector, part time positions may be available in various capacities such as program coordination, research, administration, fundraising, or advocacy. Full time work in the development sector involves dedicating the majority of one's working hours to employment within organizations that focus on social and economic development, humanitarian aid, or advocacy for marginalized communities. Full-time positions in the development sector can include roles such as project management, program implementation, monitoring and evaluation, policy analysis, community outreach, and fundraising. Full time employment offers people the opportunity to engage deeply in addressing social issues and making a sustained impact within the sector. This lecture elaborated on the skills required to work in the development sector, including subject matter knowledge, project management, communication skills, networking and collaboration, advocacy, language skills, administrative work, documentation, research and analytical skills. The positions of work in the development sector include the management level and the field level. The lecture was helpful and informative for students as it also provided a list of links to websites where they may apply for jobs. The lecture also discussed a number of






interesting and unique case studies of professional experience in the development sector.

#### 13. Summary of the Discussion in the Interactive Session:

The lecture by the resource person was followed by an interactive session coordinated by Mr. Debaditya Dutta. Although there were not many questions from the students, the resource person assured the students that she is available on email for queries and questions that appear to them later on. Some teachers shared their valuable opinion on the incisive case-studies shown by the resource person, which reflected the depth and rigour of the kind of work she has been doing in the development sector.


#### 14. Participant Composition:

There were about 31 participants in the online session, including students and faculty members of the college. Among the 31 participants, 21 provided their feedback.









14.1: Composition of the Participants based on Semester:

Diagram 14.1 represents that majority (38.1%) of the student participants in the program are from the fourth semester. About 33.3% are from the second semester and 28.6% are from the sixth semester respectively.

#### **14.2:** Composition of the Participants based on Departments/Stream:




Diagram 14.2 illustrates that majority of the participants were from sociology (about 72%). There were also participants from other disciplines or streams like English, Social Work, Zoology and BA General programme.





#### 15. Feedback Analysis:

The feedback received from the participants in the career counseling session is highly positive as reflected in their responses in questions in the feedback form circulated towards the end of the session.

#### Diagram 15.1: Rating of the talk/lecture by the students and participants on a scale of 1 to 5





Diagram 15.1 illustrates that a significant majority of 81% of the participants rated the session 5 out of 5. Another 9.5% of the respondents rated the session 4 out of 5. In total, responses of 90% of the respondents reflect a highly positive feedback about the session or the lecture delivered by the resource person.

#### Diagram 15.2: Rating of the entire program by the students and participants on a scale of 1 to 5

Diagram 15.2 depicts that a majority of 71.4% of the respondents rated the entire program 5 out of 5. Another 14.3% rated the program 4 out of 5. In short, close to 85% of the respondents rated the program highly positively and favourably.






Diagram 15.3 illustrates that a massive majority of 95.2% of the respondents stated that they benefitted from the program and only a small minority, close to 5% could be not decided or reach a firm opinion.

#### 16. Conclusion:

The first session of the series of online and offline interactive sessions on Career Prospects in Sociology and Sciences, with special focus on the Development or NGO sector as a Career Option, generated a tremendous response from the students and faculty members. The concrete inputs by the resource person were widely appreciated, with some students showing interest to communicate with the resource person and the organizers personally. Future sessions will focus on diverse career options like lecturership, full-time research career, administration and health counseling. Together, these lectures or interactive sessions, with invited speakers or in-house resource persons, will enable students gain insight into the diverse career options available beyond formal academic training.


