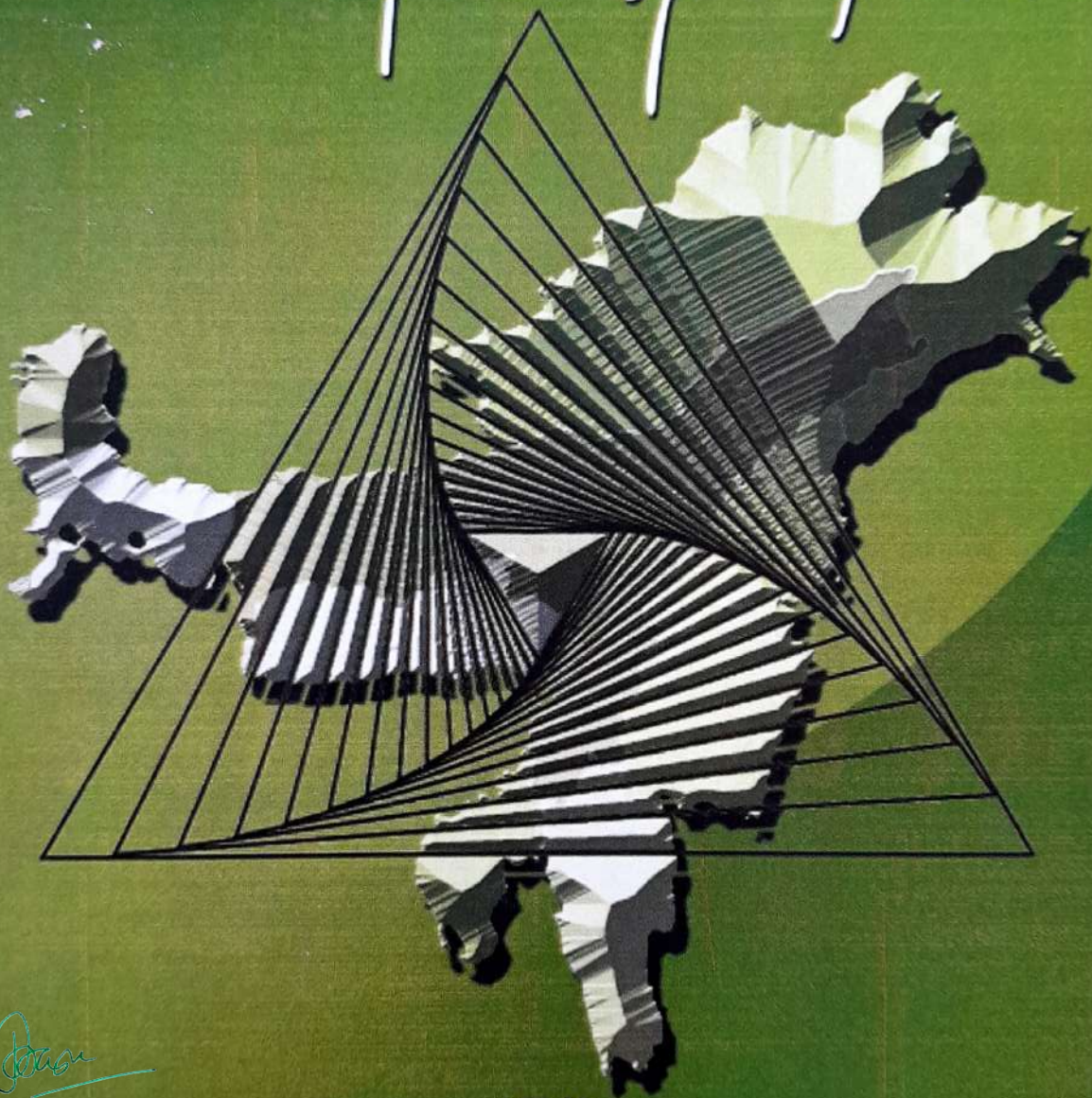

Indian Federation and Social Exclusion- The Problems of North-East

In simple terms social exclusion refers to the process by which an individual, a particular sector of the society or entire community is barred from accessing the opportunities which are available to the other members of that society. Bryan Berry defined socially excluded persons as -(a).he or she is geographically resident in a society but (b).for reason beyond his or her control, he or she cannot participate in the normal activities of citizens in that society, and (c,)he or she would like to participate.

Social exclusion is a multidimensional process, many factors play a pivotal role behind it and the geographical location is one of the influential components which foster the process. For a country like India, which contains a predominantly diverse geography-from Kashmir to Kanyakumarika and every constituting part is different from another. To guard, such an assorted geography, proper allocation of the resources to meet the divergences, these are the leading issues under which the whole machinery revolves around after independence to until now. The developing unrest in different parts of India is a systematic failure of the state mechanism to frame the right policy and implement at the right time.
