Accommodation & food availed by willing outstation participants at the guest house of the University of Burdwan, shall be self paid. **As per the new UGC guideline [F.No. 1-13/2017 (HRDC) Dt: 04.06.2018] participants are no longer eligible for any Dearness Allowance (DA), however, they are entitled to Travelling Allowance (TA) subject to the condition of the further amendment of the New UGC Guidelines for HRDCs (issued on 19.03.2019). Before or during the course(s), if the Revised Guideline is received, provision of self payment for food and lodging at Guest House may be altered.**

Accommodation (self paid) will be available only to those who will seek for it on and from 16.08.2019 to 29.08.2019 (Reporting time 8:00 am at Tarabag Guest house on 16.08.2019).

Local participants are not entitled for TA/DA. The teachers of colleges that do not yet come within the purview of section 2 (f) & 12 (B) of the UGC Act, but have been affiliated to a university for at least two years, are eligible to participate in the programmes/courses. However, they won't be paid any allowances for attending these courses.

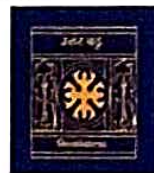




