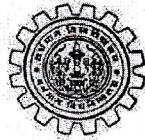

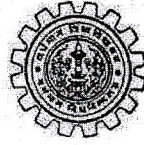


**Observation** : The members of the inspecting team discuss the preliminary infrastructure to be required at the time of introduction of Pass and Honours courses in English, Bengali, History, Political Science and Sociology with the Principal of the college and the teachers of the respective departments of the college. During discussion Principal and the teachers have expressed their urgency to start the Pass and Honours courses in the aforesaid subjects from the Session 2015-16.

The members of the team observed that the new building of the said college will be ready to commence the new courses after one and half month. The team observed that the college is supposed to ready classes with the following rooms :

1. Principal's Room
2. Office Room
3. 16 class rooms
4. Library room with reading room attached with it
5. Seminar Hall
6. Toilet for boys
7. Toilet for girls
8. Staff Room
9. Students' common room for boys
10. Students' common room for girls

From the lay-out of the plan it is observed that the total covered area is 1843.657 sq. mtr. In the ground floor 914.352 sq. mtr. and 871.984 sq. mtr. in 1<sup>st</sup> floor. The




members of the team observed that rest of the works for the ready use to conduct classes are going on.



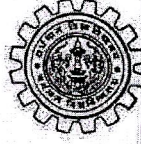





After a threadbare discussion with the officer-in-charge and the faculties of the different departments, the members of the inspecting team are of the opinion that Govt. General Degree college, Mangalkote, Burdwan may be granted extension of affiliation of Pass and Honours courses in English, Bengali, History, Political Science and Sociology with effect from academic session 2015-16 subject to the fulfillment of certain conditions viz. :

1. All the class rooms be furnished for conducting the classes.
2. There should be development of playground, gardens etc.
3. To run the subjects the college will procure books worth of 1 lakh in English, 1 lakh in Bengali, fifty thousand in History, fifty thousand in Political Science & fifty thousand in Sociology.
4. There should be one (1) Librarian and required Library Assistants who run the library smoothly.

In fine, the members of the team also pointed out that a routine inspection will also be held at the end of the academic session 2015-16 with a view to assess the progress made so far abiding by the certain conditions as mentioned above for future course of action to be taken in this regard.
