About the Speaker:

Dr. Aratrika Bhattacharya holds a Bachelor's degree in Sociology from Lady Brabourne College, University of Calcutta, and a Master's degree from the University of Hyderabad. She earned her PhD in Sociology from Presidency University, Calcutta, with a research stint at the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS), University of London. Her doctoral thesis largely dealt with the politics of the performative contexts of the Baul songs in performance in Bengal and beyond where she extensively used ethnography as a Data Collection method during her PhD research. With experience as a Teaching Fellow in the Teach for India programme advocating for educational equity and working with the Public Health Foundation of India on a project that conducted a qualitative study to explore the factors affecting reporting of AEFI in Health System in India specifically in Burdwan district and Kolkata, Dr. Bhattacharya has been teaching undergraduate Sociology for many years under the University of Burdwan. She has published in reputed journals and books and delivered invited lectures across India. Her interests include religion and globalization, culture studies, sociology of aesthetics and music, research methods and techniques and philosophical issues in social research.
