NOTIFICATION

All Heads of Institutions (HoIs) of Government and Government-aided Colleges and Private Institutions are hereby requested to observe **Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Fortnight** from **23 June to 6 July, 2026** marking his **Death Anniversary (23 June 2026)** and **Birth Anniversary (6 July 2026)** through suitable educational and commemorative activities.

The objective of the observance is to promote awareness of the life, works, writings, and contributions of **Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee** among students, teachers, and staff.

Institutions are instructed to undertake the following activities during the fortnight:

2. Organize at least **3-4 programmes** during the fortnight, such as:
 - o Memorial Lectures;
 - o Seminars;
 - o Essay Competitions;
 - o Debates;
 - o Reading Sessions on his writings and speeches;
 - o Exhibitions highlighting his life and contributions.
3. Develop and disseminate resource materials for use within the institution.
4. Explore archival materials available from the Directorate of State Archives.

All HEIs are instructed to ensure active participation of students and faculty members and to organize the programmes in a befitting manner.

A brief report on the activities conducted, along with geo-tagged photographs and relevant documents, may be maintained by the institution for record and future reference. **This may be treated as urgent and complied with accordingly.**


