RESOLUTIONS OF THE TEACHERS' COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 16.01.2025:

ITEM 1: RECONSTITUTION OF VARIOUS COMMITTEES OF THE TEACHERS' COUNCIL IN VIEW OF TRANSFER AND NEW APPOINTMENT/JOINING OF FACULTY MEMBERS.

Various academic and related committees necessary for smooth functioning of the college were revised/reconstituted, in view of transfer and new appointment/joining of faculty members in various departments, as per the unanimous decision of the members of the Teachers' Council, vide Notification **No.TC.3/25 Dated 17/01/2025**.
